



### ***Chaete Treat “Formula 53”™***

**Chaete** (as in polychaete) **Treat “Formula 53”™** is a fresh, specially formulated liquid diet containing 100% aquacultured polychaetes, North American Kelp, Nutritional Yeast and RO/DI water. The **“Formula 53”** diet has the same liquid base found in all our diets, but has been screened to remove all particles greater than 53 microns. This diet is great for corals, gorgonians, clams, scallops, most other filter feeders, invertebrates as well it makes a great enrichment for live cultures of rotifers, artemia nauplii, copepods, daphnia and any other filter-feeding live cultures. We thank you for trying our product, so just sit back and enjoy the benefits.

#### **Directions For Use:**

Quantity and the number of times you feed are going to vary based on tank size and the amount of organisms that call your tank home. So use our guidelines as a starting point and tweak as needed.

Most important is to make sure you feed when the filtration has been turned off. Any type of powerhead used to encourage flow in the tank can be left on if you are dispersing the diet. If you care to target feed, it may be best to shut down all circulation for a while. Always monitor your tank during this time.

#### **Shake well and often while feeding, product will settle.**

For **dispersal feeding**, start with 50 ml per 100 gallons, every other day or as you determine is best for your set-up. It may be best to split up feedings.

For **target feeding**, pour into a small container and use a small pipette to feed. It may be necessary to cut off the tip of small-bore pipettes.

For **enriching**, concentrate live organisms in about 1 liter of fresh culture water, add 7-10 ml of diet and allow to feed 20-30 minutes.

Most important, this product is fresh and contains no preservatives; it must be refrigerated and has a shelf life of 30 days. If you purchase a case or half case, you can freeze what you are not currently using and the product is good for 12+ months. The diet has a very unique smell; this is what makes it good, so become familiar with it. Each batch has a lot number that is the production date, i.e., Lot #091015 is a batch that was produced and frozen on October 15, 2009. All product is maintained frozen and the 30-day shelf life begins once thawed.
